What wording should I use in my will?

You should consult your solicitor or professional advisor. However, we recommend the following wording:

“I bequeath to the Coast Community Broadcasters Inc t / a todayscountry94one for its general purposes (the whole) or (a specific amount or gift) or (a percentage) or (the residue) of my estate free of all duties for which a receipt from the Honorary Secretary or Chair or other authorised person shall be a full discharge to my executor.”

Why does todayscountry94one need my bequest?

We receive no direct government financial support for the operation of the Station. A major part of the income required to operate the Station comes from the music lovers who appreciate the service we provide all day, every day. Without this support, the Station would eventually cease to exist.

If I decide to leave a bequest to todayscountry94one what form should it take?

All bequests are appreciated equally. There are several options for bequests:

1. Specific Gift

This specifies an amount of money or property or some other asset.

2. Percentage or Fractional Bequest

This specifies that a percentage or fraction of the total value of your estate be willed to todayscountry94one

3. Residual Bequest

This wills to todayscountry94one the remainder of your estate after all expenses have been met and all other beneficiaries have received their inheritances.

4. Whole Estate

This wills the value of your entire estate to todayscountry94one

May I nominate how my bequest is to be used?

Yes, you may, but it is preferred that you delegate this responsibility to the Coast Community Broadcasters Inc. Board of Directors, who are all dedicated volunteers and are aware of the Station's needs and priorities which can change with the passage of time.

How do I change my will to nominate todayscountry94one as a beneficiary?

An amendment, known as a codicil, can be made easily by your Solicitor for a small fee.

Will my bequest be recognised if I so choose?

Unless you choose to remain anonymous, your bequest will be recognised on the todayscountry94one's Honour Board located in the Board Room of the Station, and an annual commemoration on air with song request, and a short obituary in the memory of the donor or donor's nominee.
